## WOLF DINNER TRAIN MENU

Experience elegant dining on the rails as it was during the golden age of rail travel in the United States. This enchanting two hour and fifteen minute ride through the beautiful Des Moines River Valley features historic 1950's passenger cars used on the Union Pacific Railroad's famous "City of Los Angeles" and "City of San Francisco" streamliners which traveled between Chicago and the west coast. This train crosses the 156' tall Bass Point Creek High Bridge, as well as the Des Moines River, on its journey through the scenic Des Moines River Valley. After passing through the old coal mining town of Fraser, the dinner train climbs its way back out of the river valley on an impressive grade. It will make its way across some of Iowa's rich farmland, eventually making its way to the end of the line at the unincorporated town of Wolf. At Wolf the crew will make preparations for the trip back down the hill, and soon you will begin your return trip to the depot at Boone.

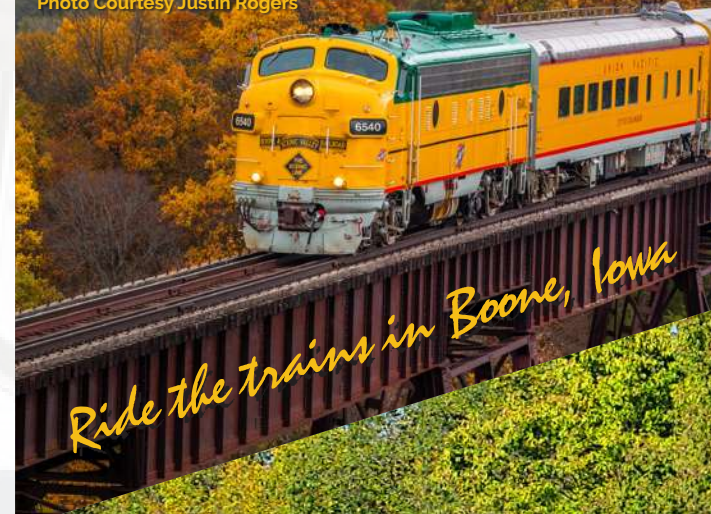

**MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND THROUGH OCTOBER 31**

The Fraser Excursion, our basic train ride, a 14 mile round trip ride (offering four levels of service) takes you from our depot, through the Des Moines River Valley, and to the old mining community of Fraser where our railroad got its start. En route you will cross the **156' tall Bass Point Creek High Bridge** as well as the Des Moines River.

# MOTORCAR RIDES

Each motorcar excursion crosses our 156' tall Bass Point Creek High Bridge and the Des Moines River Bridge.

**Trackman Excursion: \$25**

A one hour ride from Boone to the river bottom and return.

**Section Foreman Excursion: \$40**

A two hour ride through the river valley, to the end of our line at Wolf, and return.
